- We provide donations of basic needs to underprivileged homes, e.g., orphanages, old people's homes, etc.
- Youth in Action was established in February 2022 to help young people realize their personal ambitions and give them the tools, tactics, and strategies to deliver on their aspirations.
- We have been doing this through high-performance training, personal development book drives, mentorship, and various other donations.
- About 70% of our population are youths, and we strongly believe that by empowering them through high-performance trainings we will be contributing towards the economic stability of our nation.

A Brief Story About Youth In Action

Established on February 28, 2022,

- We are proudly based in Harare, Zimbabwe. Since our inception, we've experienced significant growth, expanding from just 4 members to 84 members as of October 17, 2024.
- Through our involvement in various charity initiatives, we observed that many
 organizations focus solely on providing material aid, which often offers only short-term
 relief. We wanted to create a lasting impact, offering something deeper and more
 meaningful. This led us on a journey of discovery to find the best way to support those
 in need.
- Our research revealed that the most valuable gift we can offer—whether to those who
 are disabled, blind, or facing poverty—is the realization of their personal purpose and
 ambition. By helping individuals understand their own potential, we provide them with
 the strategies, tools, and support they need to pursue their goals with passion and
 determination, empowering them to live a life of purpose.





HIGH-PERFORMANCE (HP) TRAINING

- We provide high-performance trainings to leaders of clubs and societies at the university institutions and other youthled organizations in Zimbabwe.
- These are designed to empower and equip youth leaders with the skills needed to excel in their personal and professional lives.
- This dynamic training focuses on fostering leadership, teamwork, and resilience, providing participants with valuable tools to unlock their full potential.
- Led by expert facilitators, the event features interactive workshops, motivational talks, and practical exercises that encourages participants to push their limits, develop a growth mindset, and build confidence.
- In 2024, we had 3 Trainings, with an average of 35 attendees each.
- We had Dr. Rinos Mautsa, John Cole, Arthur Bobo, Melody C. Makuwaza, and Laurence I. Sithole attending as trainers.
- Training types include: Marketing, Finance, Research & Development, Project management, Team management and Leadership.





DONATION TO TEEN MOMS

- We host heartwarming events dedicated to supporting single teen moms residing in places around Harare such as Chitungwiza, Budiriro, Mufakose etc.
- With this drive we aim to provide much-needed resources and encouragement to young mothers, ensuring they have the essentials to care for themselves and their children.
- We not only help meet the immediate needs of these teen moms but also created a space for them to connect, share experiences, and feel empowered through trainings.
- Our recent training and donation to teen mothers was on 30 November 2024, during the 16-days of Activism against Gender Based Violence.
- · We had 40 ladies in attendance.
- We had 4 ladies, two who were once teen mothers offering empowerment and training.
















DONATION OF BASIC NEEDS




